

STAY SAFE IN THE KITCHEN

Use this simple checklist to make sure you are always safe in the kitchen.

- Never** leave cooking unattended
- Don't** leave children alone in the kitchen. Make sure matches and saucepan handles are out of their reach
- Keep** tea towels, cloths and clothing **away** from the cooker and hob
- Keep** electrical leads, plugs and appliances **away** from water. Look after your kitchen appliances, **check recall lists** #whitegoodssafety
- Where possible, **use** spark devices instead of matches or lighters to light gas cookers
- Double **check** the cooker is **off** when you have finished cooking and don't leave anything on the hob
- Keep** your **cooker** clean and in good working order. A build-up of fat, oil or grease can **cause a fire**
- Make sure you have **working smoke alarms** and **test them weekly** #testittuesday
- In the event of a fire in your kitchen, **get out, stay out and call 999**
