



Service Chaplain

North Wales Fire and Rescue Service Area Volunteer, 4 hours per week

We are looking to appoint a team of Service Chaplains to support the wellbeing of Service employees and their families across the North Wales Fire and Rescue Service area (Anglesey, Gwynedd, Conwy, Denbighshire, Flintshire and Wrexham).

The successful candidates will contribute to delivering high-quality chaplaincy care to employees and their families where required, often dealing with highly emotive situations as part of a team of Chaplains working across the Service area to deliver an efficient and empathetic service.

You will be an effective communicator, with the ability to analyse and use initiative in sometimes highly emotive situations. You will also possess good organisational skills to manage your own workload, and you will need to be flexible and adaptable to change to deal with requests as they arise and can work independently. Ideally you will have the ability to communicate confidently and fluently in Welsh, but we will consider applications from individuals who are committed to improve their Welsh language skills with support from the Service.

The team will be located across the Service area, but where possible you will provide chaplain services in your local area. The role may also provide support to other areas of the Service and therefore some travel within the Service area may be required, with travel reimbursed.

Please note that this post is subject to pre-employment checks including a DBS Check, Drug and Alcohol test and satisfactory references. If a positive disclosure (spent or unspent) is received on the DBS, a risk-based approach on managing the information will be adopted by the Service and a reasonable and proportionate decision is then made regarding the current or prospective employee.
