WELSH ASSEMBLY GOVERNMENT CONSULTATION ON A PROPOSED PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT FRAMEWORK AND PERFORMANCE INDICATORS FOR FIRE AND RESCUE AUTHORITIES IN WALES

Purpose of Report

1. To present, for approval, a draft response from the Authority to a Welsh Assembly Government consultation on a proposed new Performance Measurement Framework and Performance Indicators for Fire and Rescue Authorities in Wales.

Background

2. As part of the Fire and Rescue Service National Framework, the Welsh Assembly Government (WAG), working with stakeholders including the three fire and rescue services, has drawn up a performance measurement framework for Fire and Rescue Authorities (FRAs) in Wales, which includes four groups of performance indicators.



Introduction

- 3. The proposed performance management framework and two groups of performance indicators National Strategic Indicators and Core Indicators are presented for comment in the consultation which continues until December 20th 2007. A copy of the consultation document is attached for members' information as Appendix 2.
- **4.** The consultation invites the Authority to comment on three key questions relating to the proposed framework, and on the detail of the proposed indicators.
